Candidates show demonstration of BILA fieldwork criteria through <a href="#">Terms 1- 3 coursework</a> , as well as successful completion of CSET LOTE III and V.</p> <p>(p. 2, BILA Program Review)</p>

Provide clarification.</p>	<p>For all guiding teachers for BILA placements, the fieldwork office verifies BCLAD/BILA or equivalency through the state's credentialing agency's on-line services. The same process is used for out of state placements. Provide clarification.</p>	<p>We do not have international candidates.</p> <p><b>Guiding Teachers and Placements for BILA Credential Candidates</b> In Term 2 Candidates seeking the BILA follow the same progression of gradual release teaching as do all other Candidates. The BILA candidates are placed in classrooms with English Language Learners and a teacher who is fluent in Spanish and holds the Bilingual Authorization/BCLAD or equivalent. Dual language placements are most desirable and sought when available. When not available a bilingual setting is used and student demonstrate teaching ELs in English as well as work with a BILA supervisor to meet primary language requirements during term 3. In Term 3, BILA Candidates are also placed in classrooms with English Language Learners and a teacher who holds the Bilingual Authorization.
